

Education Office (456-2615). Provides educational opportunities and services to the Barksdale community. Programs include undergraduate, graduate, professional military, high school completion and testing services.

Equal Opportunity (456-8003). Ensures compliance with the Air Force equal opportunity policy against unlawful discrimination and sexual harassment.

Family Advocacy (456-6595). Provides assessments and assistance for domestic violence and child abuse issues. Also provides violence prevention education, classes on anger management and stress management.

Family Child Care (456-3354). Air Force licensed childcare providers (18 years and older), residing on or near the base, provide childcare on a part-time or full-time basis in their home. Call for a listing of current providers.

Health and Wellness Center (456-6011). Offers wellness evaluations, tobacco cessation, heart disease/cancer awareness, diet/exercise classes & healthy cooking classes.

Hearts Apart Program (456-8400). A program designed to serve as a link between the Deployed Service member & their spouse/family. Hearts Apart includes morale calls and writing kits for children.

Inspector General (456-5049). Provides varied problem-solving assistance. Investigates allegations of inappropriate conduct, fraud, Waste and Abuse. It is recommended the prescribed grievance channels and/or the chain of command be utilized as the first course of action for perceived violations.

Legal Services (456-2562). Provides legal advice concerning personal and civil matters. Services include powers of attorney, wills, taxes and more.

Loan Locker (456-2400). Now located on the pool side of the Stripes Club.

Mental Health Clinic (456-6600). Provides quality care and services relating to the emotional/psychological health and wellness of Air Force personnel.

Managed Care Office (456-6572). Provides information and assistance with TRICARE benefits and services.

Military & Family Life Consultant (918-9379). Provides short term, situational, problem-solving counseling services to service members & their families.

Military Personnel Customer Service (456-3710). Provides ID cards and other services for active duty members, retirees, and their family members.

New Parent Support Program (456-6595). Provides education and support to expectant parents or parents with children under the age of two. Registered nurses provide home visits and education.

Part Day Enrichment (456-4139). Preschool available up to five days a week for children 3 to 5 years old. Nutritious snacks, hands on curriculum, arts and crafts, music, dramatic play, story time and field trips are provided. Call for detailed information regarding facility and guidelines.

Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC) (456-7272). Provides coordination of care for victims of sexual assault including protection and appropriate medical treatment/care. Victim Advocates are available. Call for information or to report a sexual assault.

School Liaison Officer (SLO) (456-8400). The SLO serves as a conduit of school information and is the primary point of contact for public and private school matters.

Special Needs Identification/Assignment Coordination (SNIAC) (456-6567). Determines the availability of medical and special education services for dependants. Supports and assists families with Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) enrollment.

Volunteer Resource Program (456-8400). The Volunteer Resource Program is a base wide program managed by the Airman & Family Readiness Center offering volunteer opportunities in a variety of professional settings.

Youth Center (456-3448). Provides youth with opportunities to develop their physical, social, emotional and cognitive abilities and to experience achievement, leadership, enjoyment, friendship and recognition. Call for details.

Airman's Attic (456-2400). Now located at the Stripes Club- Pool Side.

Airman & Family Readiness Center (456-8400). Offers: Career Focus, Personal/Work Life Education, Information & Referral, Personal Financial Management, Personal & Family Readiness, Relocation, Transition Assistance, Volunteer Resource Program & Discovery Resource Center (computer access, books, DVDs & videos on a variety of topics).

Alcoholics Anonymous. (865-2172) Assists in recovery from alcoholism/alcohol abuse and provides support/education. Call for meeting info.

Alcohol/Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment (ADAPT) (456-6595). Educates community about substance abuse and helps return identified substance abusers to unlimited duty status or to assist them in their transition to civilian life.

American Red Cross. (Off Base) (865-9545) Offers emergency communications with families outside the local area. Provides classes in CPR, Healthy Baby, babysitter training, latch-key training, water safety and more.

Centerpoint (227-2100). Information and referral service for the civilian community.
