INSTALLATION HISTORY

Constructed on 22,000 acres of cotton fields in the 1930s, Barksdale Air Force Base has grown into one of the U.S. Air Force's premier installations.

As the host unit, the 2nd Bomb Wing (2 BW) delivers devastating combat capability through deployable aircraft and personnel capable of executing both nuclear and conventional combat missions, while maintaining an elite force of expeditionary Airmen in support of combatant commanders around the world. The 2 BW oversees all aircraft maintenance and provides standardized weapons loading and academics training in support of the wing's annual 757 sorties and 5,259 flying hours. As the 2 BW celebrates its 70th year at Barksdale, it remains a vital component to the United States' national security objectives and home of the world's most versatile bomber fleet.

Barksdale also serves as the headquarters for the Air Force's newest major command, Air Force Global Strike Command, as well as Headquarters 8th Air Force and the 307th Bomb Wing. Barksdale has a long and distinguished history of supporting a variety of aircraft, which have participated in conflicts around the world. Its pivotal role continues as Barksdale provides a key component of our nation's nuclear deterrent, its conventional combat air power and its expeditionary readiness.
